


SEND and Inclusion Reviews

SEND and Inclusion Reviews can be commissioned at an individual school level or multi-academy trust level.

- Individual Academy £900







1. Reflect

Material to engage with before starting the process. Usually something to read, something to watch and something to do. This will be negotiated with leaders in line with trust priorities and may include a 1 hour online session looking at 'What is inclusion?'.

2. Self-Assess

The multi-academy trust or academy will self-assesses against the SEND and Inclusion framework.

3. Visit

Visits and meetings will be agreed with MAT leaders in line with trust priorities and design of the review.

4. Action Plan

In collaboration, and following the previous steps the SEND and Inclusion Hub will then provide an action plan template and offer support and challenge to the plan.

5. Bespoke Support

It may be, at this stage, the MAT would like to invest in further support from the SEND and Inclusion Hub.

6. Review

After a period of time, the SEND and Inclusion Hub will then return and review the progress made against the initial self-assessment and review any next steps.
